#### i. Participation

#### 1. Camp review

Concession made \$200-300 each night.

Sold lots of hotdogs and hamburgers.

Cheer camp was organized chaos, but it went well. HS Cheerleaders did a good job. Kids all enjoyed it.

Dawn and Heather aren't sure if the cheer team knows that they got the check. Susan will follow up with them.

#### 2. Pool party review

Was really good for the younger kids. Would have been nice to have more HS players, but it might have been short notice.

Made good money from concessions. (Another \$2-300). Could probably have sold another whole watermelon. If we do it again would probably concentrate more on picnic foods and less on hot foods.

#### ii. Concession Stand (Dru)

Working on getting final schedule. Scrimmage on 8/17 is a go.

#### 1. Volunteer signups

Dru talked to a number of people during equipment handouts. Many are willing to help. Will get the Sign-Up Genius put together as soon as the final schedule.

Looking for another tablet to use with the Square app to track purchases. Dru is going to donate a grill after he upgrades the burners. Heather will donate an older tablet.
